(*) = this option is at the director's discretion. Limited attendance only works with children who transition quickly and happily to complex social situations.

Breakfast is served between 8 and 9 AM. If your child arrives later and needs to eat, please let us know.

Definitions:

Full Time: The child may arrive any time at or after 7AM and leaves anytime by or before 6PM. We serve breakfast, lunch and snack. The day includes a nap or a rest time, depending on the child's age and needs.

Part time attendance: Parents can choose the level of care that best suits their needs, their child and their budget. In our experience, consistent and frequent attendance are important components in a successful transition to our center. The sheer amount of time spent with us directly correlates to children's trust & comfort levels. To that end, we encourage parents to choose *at least two consecutive* days, whenever possible. If you are interested in part time options, let us know. Communication and flexibility are key to getting most families the exact schedules they want and need.

AM ½ day: The child may arrive any time at or after 7AM and leaves by or before 12PM, 12:45 if slightly older. Children are not required to arrive at 7AM but we encourage arrival by 8:30. If your child needs breakfast, please try to arrive by 8:45. We know it's hard to get up and out of the house. But time spent on site with us is even more important for part time kids. They need time to develop and maintain their unique niche in the group's overall social fabric. This is a great option for children who are new to group care and children who want and/or need peer socialization.

PM ½ day: The child may arrive between 12 and 12:30PM and leaves by or before 6PM. (NO child may arrive between 1:00 and 2:00, unless cleared ahead of time with a director.) For most children, arriving a little early (10:30-11:00) for play time is essential to being able to settle down for lunch and nap. Others seem to be fine arriving at noon only a short time before lunch. In the end, successful transition to this time slot is probably affected as much by each child's temperament and personality as it is by our planning. ☺ In any event, please have a thorough discussion with Sharon or Jill if you are considering this time slot.
